Thank you for your presentation before the Mississippi River Commission during the public meeting held in Memphis, Tennessee, on August 20, 2001. During your statement you presented a slide show of some of the concepts being considered for the Memphis riverfront development master plan.

The Mississippi River Commission was pleased to learn of the assistance the Memphis District provided your office in the development of the master plan through the Planning Assistance to States authority. As you are aware, the Memphis District contracted with Cooper, Robertson and Partners, an architect engineering firm from New York City, to conduct the Options Phase of the master plan study. The Options Phase was completed this month and contained a 50-year plan for riverfront development in Memphis.
