Thank you for your statement filed for the record of public meeting of the Mississippi River Commission in Caruthersville, Missouri, on April 2, 2001. In your statement you expressed appreciation for the study by the Memphis District for upgrading the Dyer County Little Levee.

The Memphis District initiated a Section 205 feasibility study in March 2001 for the purpose of determining the feasibility of flood control improvements to the Dyer County Little Levee. The District will complete a preliminary assessment of Federal interest in June 2001 to determine if further feasibility analyses are warranted. Our staff in Memphis will keep you updated on the study as it progresses.

The Commission appreciates your comments and will be pleased to hear from you again at future meetings.
