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Sloan selected Assistant Division Counsel



VICKSBURG, Miss., June 1, 2005 – Ms. G. Rogers Sloan was recently selected as Assistant Division Counsel for the Mississippi Valley Division/Mississippi River Commission. In this position she provides legal advice and counsel to the division commander and staff. She also serves as Legal Services Program Manager for the New Orleans, Memphis and St. Paul districts within the division.

Prior to joining the division, Ms. Sloan worked for the Corps' New Orleans District in New Orleans, La. She started her career in private practice and entered federal service with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in 1986. She has also served tours of duty with the Corps' Vicksburg District, Baltimore District and the headquarters office in Washington, D.C.

Ms. Sloan earned her bachelor's degree in political science from the University of the South, Sewanee, Tenn., her juris doctor degree from the University of Mississippi, Oxford, Miss., and her master of laws degree from George Washington University, Washington, D.C.
