




- 9-foot channel maintenance



3,462 STRUCTURES ELIGIBLE TO

RESIDENTIAL BE RAISED

DRY FLOOD-PROOFING

Localized Reduction

The Project includes structures at or below the 2025- 25-year base flood elevation (BFE).



The Project recommends 3,462 residential structures will be considered for elevation

equivalent to the 2075 100year BFE. Qualifying residential structures will be raised approximately 5 feet on average, but no higher than 13 feet.



342 non-residential structures will be considered for dry floodproofing to 3 feet above ground.



Localized risk reduction measures (constructing berms) for 157 warehouses will be considered less than or equal to 6 feet above the ground.

NEXT STEPS

- Available Appropriations for Construction = \$296M
- Project Partnership Agreement executed in June 2023.
- A&E Services support for screening and inspections anticipated award by January 2025.
- Design Build Contracts required by Authorization.




