To be the Nations supplier of high quality, well maintained flood fight supplies and equipment before during and after a flood event; in order to enhance the US Army Corps of Engineers preparedness and reduce the Nations risk from flooding and coastal storm events.



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National Flood Fight Center Objectives



- Perform reach back support that includes emergency contracting and direct assistance to expedite delivery of flood fight materiel and technical services.
- Administer emergency IDIQ contracts to improve cost efficiencies.
- Support multiple small and large scale disaster events within CONUS Puerto Rico & Virgin Islands.
- Maximize storage capacity and reduce costs through innovative storage solutions.
- Reset USACE districts in preparation for flood season.

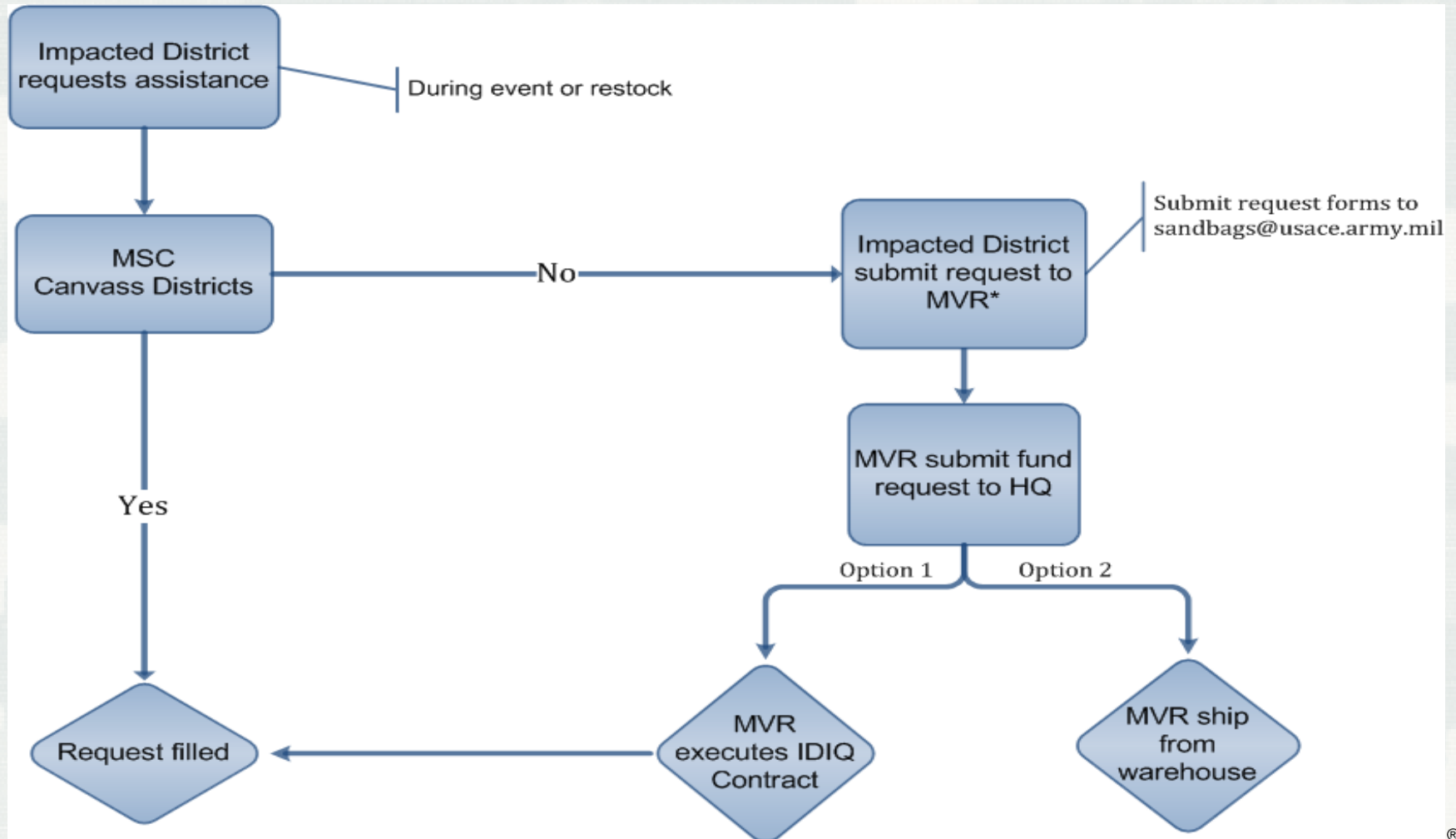
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NFFC Capabilities

- Reach back support to impacted Corps districts
- Maintain a large quantity of flood fight materiel
- Maintain ID/IQ contracts
 - ▶ Sandbags & Large Sandbags
 - ▶ Polyethylene Sheeting
 - ▶ Textile lined gabion baskets (Hesco)
- Purchase EFP for Sacramento, Omaha, Rock Island, Seattle and Philadelphia Distribution Centers
- Allocate space for additional inventory (if necessary).
- Expedited transportation capabilities
 - ▶ Two 53-foot low boy trailers

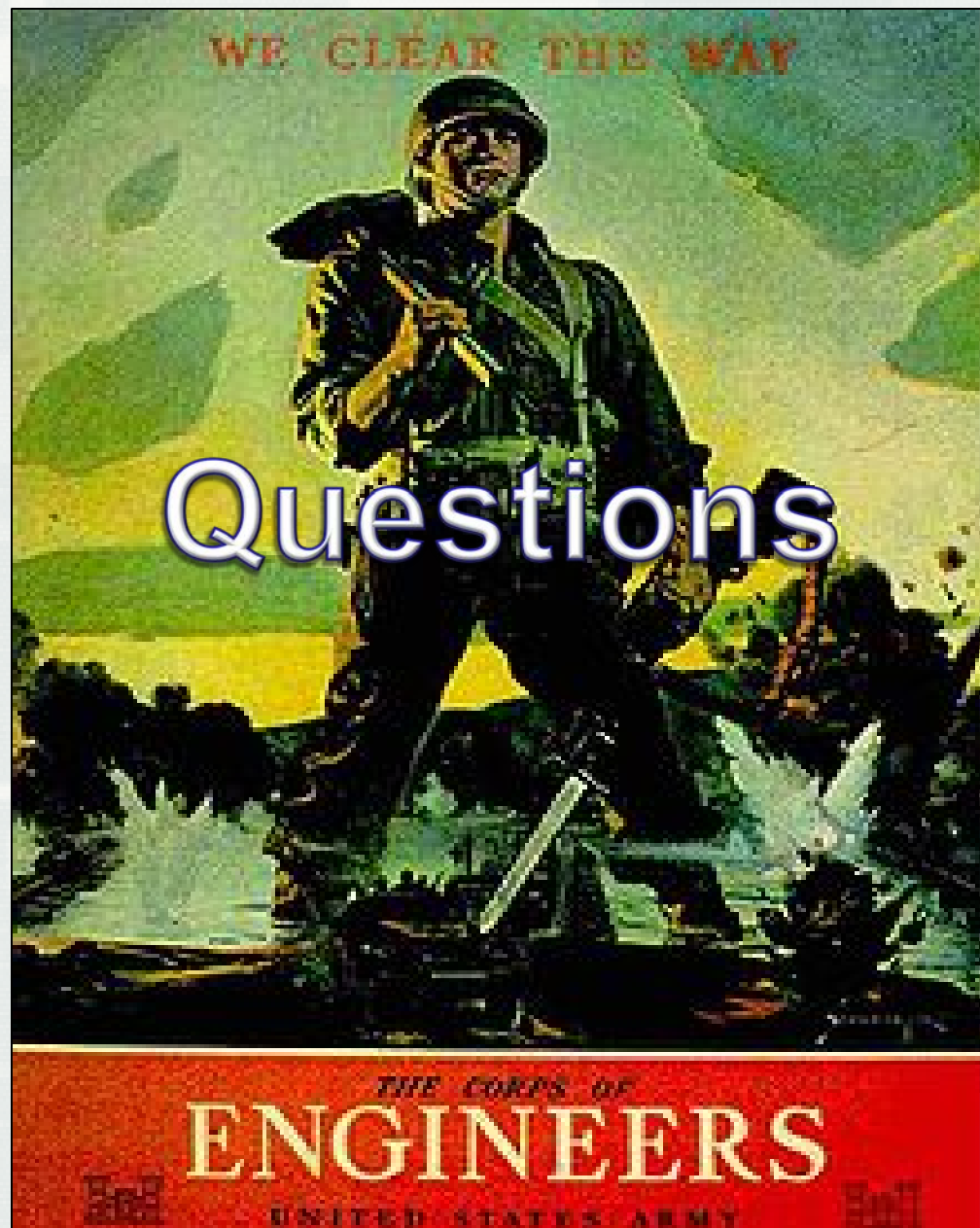
