


National Flood Fight Center Objectives




NFFC Capabilities

 - Sandbags & Large Sandbags
 - ▶ Polyethylene Sheeting
 - ▶ Textile lined gabion baskets (Hesco)
- Purchase EFFP for Sacramento, Omaha, Rock Island,
 Seattle and Philadelphia Distribution Centers
- Allocate space for additional inventory (if necessary).
- Expedited transportation capabilities
